





Tips for Using the LinkIDAHO Interactive Broadband Maps

FIND: Enter a specific street address or name of a public facility (such as a school, hospital or governmental building), then click on “Find” to instantly zoom to that location on the map...or simply click anywhere on the map to go directly to that location.





ZOOM: The map includes a tool for navigating directions and zooming in or out. Mouse wheel zooming is also available. Simply roll the mouse wheel up or down to zoom in/out.





Broadband Coverage: View the reported broadband coverage at any location on the map by selecting from a list of options, including number of providers in a given area, coverage reported by technology type, areas where no broadband coverage was reported, and broadband availability as reported by consumers.





SPEED: In the same drop-down box, you can also view advertised speeds by selecting from maximum advertised download and upload speeds for wireline (copper, fiber and cable) or wireless (fixed and mobile) service.





VIEW: View all of Idaho, map a specific latitude/longitude coordinate or display the county of your choice.




ASSIST: Users are encouraged to submit feedback regarding coverage shown or the overall usability of the map. Simply click on any area of the map to open the “Broadband Provider Information” window. At the bottom of the window, click on “Provide Coverage and Speed Feedback” and follow the instructions on the screen to complete the short survey. *Please note that your contact information will not be shared with anyone outside the LinkWISCONSIN team unless you request that we forward the information to potential providers in your area.* If you have submitted feedback regarding coverage at your location, the appropriate report icon will appear on the *Consumer Feedback Layer* (located under *Choose a Broadband Map*). You may need to “refresh” the map before you can view the results of your report.



BASE MAP: The base map, with broadband coverage layers removed, can be viewed by selecting “Base Map Only” in the “Choose a Broadband Map” drop-down box.



DISPLAY VIEWS: The maps can be displayed in three views: Street Map, Aerial Images or Terrain. Images are covered by broadband layers, when present. Select “Base Map Only” to view aerial/terrain.



County Borders are visible by choosing that option from the Map Layers Menu
